

Sir Francis Drake in the New World

Compiled by Garry D. Gitzen, Curator M. Wayne Jensen Jr. Library, Wheeler, Oregon

The following bibliographical research materials were used in determining Francis Drake's Pacific coast summer sojourn of 1579. The materials are listed by: Navigation and Surveying, Ethnography of Native Americans and Oregon Pioneers, The Spanish Period, Shipwrecks, Bancroft Library Archives and Drake Landing in California Theories; followed by an author alphabetical listing. The M. Wayne Jensen Jr. Library was collected over a lifetime by Mr. Jensen (1930-2005), Director of the Oregon Tillamook County Pioneer Museum (1976 – 2003), emphasizing 16th and 17th century Pacific Northwest history. Not all materials listed here are held within the M. Wayne Jensen, Jr. Library.
